CHANGE IN TAX LAW FOR CHARITABLE CONTRIBUTIONS – The IRS reminds us that, as part of the CARES Act, taxpayers can deduct up to \$300. in cash donations to qualifying organizations even if they choose to take the **standard deduction** rather than itemizing their deductions. Donations of up to \$300. **made before December 31, 2020**, are now deductible when people file their taxes in 2021. Further information regarding this new, temporary deduction can be found in IRS release IR-2020-264, issued on 11/25/2020 and in IRS Publication 526.
